Farmers State Bank on left at 2<sup>nd</sup> stop light, opposite State Highway Patrol Office. (250 East was 1913-1928 Lincoln Highway)

From the East: US 30 to US 250 to Ashland (1913-1928 Lincoln Highway), go over I 71 and continue one block past Wal-Mart and turn right at the stop light. Farmers State Bank is on the right opposite the State Highway Patrol Office.
